

HEDIS data collection: Initial request for records to mail in late January

Each year, we collect data for the Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS®), a core set of performance measures that provides an in-depth analysis of the quality of care that health care organizations provide to their customers.

We will mail initial requests for medical records to approximately 40,000 providers in late January. The mailing includes a list of patients and a detailed description of what is needed from each patient's medical record.

Providers can submit records electronically through a Secure File Transfer Protocol (SFTP) site, a secure fax number, or by providing us with remote access to their electronic medical record (EMR) system.
